OBJECTION

Objector Kevin Gilnack (“Objector”), a Massachusetts registered voter residing at 32 Mill Street Unit 2, Dorchester, Massachusetts 02122, hereby submits this objection, pursuant to M.G.L. c. 55B §5, to signature petitions submitted to the Secretary of the Commonwealth on or before July 1, 2026 related to Initiative Petition 25-10, entitled “An Act to Restore Sensible Marijuana Policy” (the “Initiative Petition”), specifically supplemental signatures necessary to place a state initiative question on the ballot after

rejections by the general court. Objector objects to numerous petitions and signatures on said petitions for the following reasons, without limitation:

1. Numerous signatures are not “signed substantially as registered”; see 950 CMR 55.03(4). Such signatures should not have been certified, and should not be included in the number of allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot.
2. Numerous signatures are those of persons who are not registered voters within the city or town stated, or at the address written, on the applicable petitions. Such signatures should not have been certified, and should not be included in the number of allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot.
3. Numerous signatures are not genuine. Such signatures should not have been certified, and should not be included in the number of allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot.
4. Numerous signatures were obtained through fraudulent means. Such signatures should not have been certified, and should not be included in the number of allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot.
5. Numerous signatures are those of voters who have subsequently requested that their names be removed from the applicable petitions. Such signatures should not have been certified, and therefore should not be included in the number of

allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot.

6. Numerous petitions should not have been accepted by the Secretary of the Commonwealth because they contained extraneous marks. See 950 CMR 48.07(2).

7. Numerous petitions are not exact copies of the petition form as provided by the Secretary of the Commonwealth, in that they differ from the original in paper size, color, text, or format, or otherwise fail to conform to the requirements of 950 CMR 48.02 and 48.07(2)(b). Signatures contained on such petitions should not have been certified, and should not be included in the number of allowed signatures required to qualify an initiative petition to be printed on the November 2026 ballot. See 950 CMR 48.07(2).

WHEREFORE, Objector Kevin Gilnack requests that the State Ballot Law Commission review the challenged signatures and petitions and to exercise its power to disqualify the challenged signatures and petitions, and upon disqualification and subsequent determination that fewer than 12,429 additional certified and allowed signatures for the Initiative Petition have been submitted to the Secretary of the Commonwealth, issue an order to the Secretary of the Commonwealth to deny placing the Initiative Petition on the November 2026 ballot.
